**1985 No. 169****NORTHERN IRELAND****The District Electoral Areas (Northern Ireland) Order 1985***Laid before Parliament in draft**Made - - - - - 13th February 1985**Coming into operation in accordance with Article 2*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 13th day of February 1985

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 38(1)(a) and (4) of the Northern Ireland Constitution Act 1973(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the District Electoral Areas (Northern Ireland) Order 1985.

2. This Order shall come into operation on 15th May 1985, except that for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election to be held on or after that day this Order shall come into operation forthwith.

3.— (1) For the purposes of elections to local government district councils, each district (as constituted by the Local Government (Boundaries) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984(b)) shall be divided into district electoral areas which shall bear the names set out in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order and each such area shall comprise the wards (as so constituted) specified opposite thereto in column 2 of that Schedule.

(2) The number of councillors to be elected for each district electoral area constituted by this Order shall be the number specified in column 3 of the Schedule to this Order opposite to the name of the electoral area as given in column 1 of that Schedule.

4. Article 3 of, and Schedule 1 to, the Northern Ireland (Local Elections) Order 1977(a) shall cease to have effect.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

Article 2(3) of the Local Government (Boundaries) Order (Northern Ireland) Order 1984 constitutes new wards for each local government district in Northern Ireland. Consequent on the making of that Order, the Secretary of State appointed a Commissioner under Article 3(1) of the District Electoral Areas Commissioner (Northern Ireland) Order 1984 (S.I. 1984/360). Under Article 3(2) of that Order, the Commissioner was required to submit a report setting out, in respect of each district, his recommendations for the grouping together of those wards into electoral areas for the purpose of local government elections in each of those districts. This Order gives effect, without modification, to the recommendations in the Report by the District Electoral Areas Commissioner dated 27th November 1984 and laid before Parliament under Article 5 of the District Electoral Areas Commissioner (Northern Ireland) Order 1984 on 5th December 1984.
