臺大圖書館創設於 1928 年 3 月，前身為日治時期成立的臺北帝國大學附屬圖書館，大學肇始之際，當局即著手規劃圖書館專屬建築，以因應未來學術資源入藏與利用需求，1929 年由臺灣總督府營繕課負責興建圖書館館舍，位置坐落在今天的臺大校史館，第一期工程在 1930 年啟用，隨著營運需求逐期擴建。1945 年臺灣光復，同年 11 月 15 日政府接收「臺北帝國大學」並更名為「國立臺灣大學」，圖書館亦同時改隸。

日治時期興建的圖書館，受限於空間規模，無法滿足近代圖書資訊服務需求，因此學校自 1986 年 7 月籌建新總圖書館，歷經 12 年興建終於在 1998 年 11 月正式啟用。新總圖書館延續舊圖書館建築使用的山牆、拱窗、挑高等特色，營造新時代學術殿堂氛圍，更有承先啟後的意義。圖書館遷館之際同時將校總區原有 34 所院系圖書館（室）館藏與人力集中管理，紓解過去分散式人力配置的窘困，解決讀者以往費時奔波各館（室）間查詢資料之辛勞，館員專業素養更能夠在新的空間發揮專長，提供師生多元、專業與主動式的服務。

National Taiwan University Library was founded as the Taihoku Imperial University Library in March 1928 by the Japanese colonial government. As the school was being established, the Library was built in order to support academic research. In 1929, the Library was constructed in the location of today's NTU History Gallery and began operations in 1930, expanding as time went by. At the end of World War II, the University was handed over to the government of the Republic of China and changed to its current name on November 15th, 1945. As a result, the Taihoku Imperial University Library became the National Taiwan University Library.

NTU Library as it is today officially opened to the public in November 1998 after 12 years of planning and construction. The new building was designed in the spirit of the original building: it retained the arched windows, gables, and piazza, providing a sanctuary for study in the new age. Most of the University's previously dispersed departmental libraries were integrated into the new building, and the Library is now able to provide comprehensive services.

鑑於服務型態及讀者學習模式的持續演進，圖書館於 2014 年起成立營運規劃委員會，以館舍永續使用、空間活化、服務多元創新等三大主軸，推展總圖書館空間與服務重塑計畫，於 2022 年初獲本校經濟系校友謝南強先生捐款支持，同年啟動總圖書館一樓空間改造工程，並於 2023 年 8 月完竣，期能帶給讀者嶄新的體驗與完善的服務。

本館在館藏量、特藏資源、自動化系統、創新服務、館際合作、資源推廣等營運表現，為國內各大學圖書館的標竿。同時，承擔臺大校史館營運、統籌成立臺大博物館群擔任召集重任，帶動校史傳承、匯集學術標本的文化資產價值，成為其他大學參考的典範。圖書館團隊不斷地為學術研究資源、校園文化資產蓄積能量，發揮專業的管理能力，期許在良好的軟硬體環境下與臺大學術表現共同成長，引領臺灣圖書資訊學術界及實務界共同邁向卓越。

To evolve along with the development of library services and education modes, NTU Library organized an operation and planning committee in 2014 to initiate the NTUL Remodeling Project. The project had a threefold goal: sustainable building use, making the most of the space, and service innovation. In 2022, NTU Library received a generous donation from Mr. Nan-Chiang Hsieh, the alumnus of Department of Economics. This donation enabled the start of the remodeling project on the first floor, which was reopened in August 2023, providing our patrons with a brand new experience and enhanced services.

NTU Library is currently the nation's leading university library in terms of its collection size, special collections, automation system, innovative services, interlibrary cooperation, and promotion of resources. Furthermore, the Library has undertaken operations at the NTU History Gallery and coordinated the NTU Museums. The Library has continuously devoted itself to curating academic resources and preserving campus heritage, becoming an exemplar for other university libraries within the nation.

The University Librarian presides over the operations of all NTU libraries by order of the NTU President.

副館長

Associate University Librarian

協助館長處理圖書館業務。

The Associate University Librarian assists the University Librarian in handling library operations.

圖書委員會

Library Committee

由各學院推派教師及學生代表組成，每學期召開一次會議以協助推展圖書館業務。

The Library Committee consists of professors from each college and student representatives, who offer suggestions on library operation and development in meetings convened once per semester.

◆ 館長室 Office of the University Librarian

協助館長規劃、綜理並督導執行本館各項業務。

The Office of the University Librarian assists the University Librarian in planning, overseeing, and directing the execution of various operations.

◆ 醫學圖書館 Medical Library

辦理醫學圖書館各項服務。

The Medical Library takes charge of a variety of services provided for the Medical Campus.

◆ 社會科學資源服務組 Social Sciences Resource Division

負責營運社會科學院辜振甫先生紀念圖書館及法律學院圖書館，提供各項相關服務。

This division is in charge of the operations of Koo Chen-Fu Memorial Library and the Law Library, providing various reader services.

◆ 校史館營運組 University History Affairs Division

辦理校史館參觀導覽、推廣行銷、校史徵集分享及臺大博物館群營運等業務。

This division is in charge of arranging exhibitions and tours for the NTU History Gallery, organizing extension activities, documenting the oral histories of alumni, and collecting memorials and artifacts that mark each step of the University's history. It is also responsible for coordinating campus-wide operations between the NTU Museums.

◆ 採訪編目組 Acquisitions and Cataloging Division

辦理各類型資料之徵集、交贈、分類、編目、書目資料維護以及館藏經費管理等業務。

This division is responsible for acquisitions, subscriptions, exchanges, donations, classification, and cataloging in all formats for the Library, and it is also in charge of budget control and maintenance of bibliographic records.

◆ 閱覽組 Readers Services Division

辦理閱覽、讀者服務、館際合作及流通等業務。

This division is in charge of general readers services, including circulation and interlibrary loan services.

◆ 典藏服務組 Collection Services Division

辦理館藏管理與相關服務，以及自動化書庫服務中心營運等業務。

This division oversees the maintenance of all materials in the Main Library, except for the special collections, and manages the ASRS Service Center.

◆ 學科服務組 Subject Services Division

辦理參考諮詢、利用指導、支援教師教學研究及系所聯繫等業務。

This division provides reference services and library instruction, supports teaching activities and research, as well as coordinates library-related requests from departments and institutes.

◆ 特藏組 Special Collections Division

辦理中外文善本資料、線裝書、地區研究資料、校史資料、特藏文庫等之徵集、典藏、閱覽及推廣等業務。

This division is responsible for collecting, preserving, and digitizing special collections such as rare books, thread-stitched binding collections, area studies materials, University history materials, personal collections, as well as providing readers services and extension services.

◆ 推廣服務組 Library Extension Services Division

辦理參訪導覽、推廣活動、文宣與出版品編製等業務。

This division takes charge of providing library tours, publishing manuals and brochures, as well as organizing extension activities related to the Library collections.

◆ 研究支援組 Research Support Division

應用社會網絡分析及書目計量等方法，提供領域主題探索、支援校內學術研究之創新加值服務。

This division provides innovative services via social network analysis and bibliometrics to support faculty and academic units of the University in advancing their research.

◆ 系統資訊組 Information Technology Services Division

辦理圖書資訊自動化系統、資訊設備與網路設施之管理維護工作。

This division is in charge of the operation and maintenance of automated information systems, technological devices, and internet facilities.

◆ 行政組 Administration Division

辦理預算編列、財產管理、館舍維護管理與安全清潔，以及公文收發等業務。

This division conducts comprehensive administrative tasks such as budget plans, assets management, security control, and sanitation supervision.

The Main Library houses 66 closed Study Carrels and 8 Discussion Rooms. Computers for searching the Library's online catalog, photocopiers, and Wi-Fi are available on each floor of the Library.



24 小時自習室 Study Room

24 小時自習室位於總館地下一樓，提供本校教職員生以及校友使用。自習室內部分家具沿用舊總圖書館時期的桌椅與檯燈，深具歷史意義，同時採用自動化門禁系統管理內部 821 個座位，是館內極富特色之一隅。

The 24/7 Study Room is equipped with 821 seats and is located in the basement of the Main Library. NTU faculty, students, and alumni can check in and out with their NTU identification. Most furniture here are replicas that follow the style of the Japanese colonial period of this University; however, some are originals from the past, bearing deep historical meaning.



討論區 Discussion Area

原學習開放空間於 2018 年由教學發展中心交還本館管理使用，更名為討論區，持續提供本校師生自由討論、輕鬆交談的空間服務，增進師生在課餘的學習交流。討論區包含多間討論室與沙發區等區域，是閱讀、上網或進行小型讀書會、課業討論、語言交換的好地方。

The Discussion Area was returned to Main Library from the NTU Center for Teaching and Learning Development in 2018, offering a space for NTU faculty and students to hold group meetings, organize book clubs, and have language exchange.



一樓致強大廳

Zhi-Qiang Hall

總圖書館自 2022 年 10 月起進行一樓空間改造，並於 2023 年 8 月 16 日揭牌啟用，由捐款人謝南強先生將一樓新空間命名為「致強大廳」，希望勉勵臺大人「學以致用，莊敬自強」。新空間將流通、參考諮詢及多媒體櫃臺整併為聯合服務台，提供便捷的一站式讀者服務。中軸部分為藝文展示區域，包含中央樓梯、展示區、表演舞臺，為本館空間注入活力與質感。兩側設有數位媒體區與多元共享區。數位媒體區提供多媒體設備及館藏，並設有樂活窩、討論室、演練室及團體室；多元共享區採用模矩空間設計，提供讀者討論、研究、會議、休憩等活動場所，亦可作為展演空間。一樓側邊為輕閱讀區，陳列輕鬆休閒讀物供讀者翻閱、舒緩心情。

The Main Library's first-floor remodeling project commenced in October 2022 and was reopened on August 16, 2023. The new space was named "Zhi-Qiang Hall" by the donor, Mr. Nan-Chiang Hsieh, hoping to encourage NTUers to "apply what they have learned and strive for self-reliance with dignity." Zhi-Qiang Hall included several highlights. First, circulation, reference, and multimedia services were integrated into one counter to serve visitors more comprehensively. Second, an art gallery was added, featuring a central stairway, exhibition areas, and a Performance Stage to elevate the dynamic in the Library. Third, the Digital Media Commons was built for users to enjoy multimedia services individually or in groups and to promote digital independent learning. Fourth, the Collaboration Commons adopted a flexible structure to fulfill various needs for spaces, such as meetings, seminars, or presentations. Last but not least, the Light Reading Area offered a delightful collection for readers to ease their minds. As a result, the Remodeling Project not only improved the functionality of the Library, but also brought diversity to the space and an enlightening atmosphere.



日然廳

日然廳是一多功能展演場域，可提供各界租借辦理各類藝文展覽、工作坊、座談會、演講等活動。本空間承蒙受業於楊日然教授門下 1977 級法律系校友捐款闢建，命名日然廳以感念教授恩澤，於 2013 年 12 月 4 日楊教授八十冥誕日揭牌啟用。楊日然教授曾任本校法律學系系主任、法研所所長，兼任本館館長 8 年有餘，後由總統提名任命為第四、五屆司法院大法官，深受學界及司法實務界推崇。

Zu-Zan Hall

Zu-Zan Hall is a multifunctional space for organizing exhibitions, workshops, symposiums, and lectures. Donated by the Class of 1977 alumni of the NTU College of Law, Zu-Zan Hall was built in memory and honor of Professor Zu-Zan Yang and opened on December 4th, 2013, Professor Yang's 80th birth anniversary.

The late Prof. Zu-Zan Yang was the Dean of NTU's College of Law, Chair of the Graduate Law Institute, Grand Justice for the fourth and fifth term, and University Librarian for more than eight years, earning much respect from the academic and the legal community.



臺大人文庫

NTU Collected Works

臺大人文庫是圖書館打造專屬臺大人的典藏空間，積極收藏豐富多元的臺大人著作，彰顯臺大人整體學術出版能量，同時讓尚在校就讀之莘莘學子從學長姊的著作中進行典範學習，延續學術脈動。此空間承蒙川流基金會董事長李華林博士（1957年藥學系畢業）、余舜華博士（1959年農化系畢業）及鄭富美女士（1964年護理系畢業）三位校友慷慨捐款贊助，於2007年校慶日開幕，啟用至今已彙集800餘位校友逾8,800件圖書。



The NTU Collected Works room was funded through generous donations from three NTU alumni: Dr. Hwalin Lee, Chairman of the Chuan Lyu Foundation (Class of 1957, School of Pharmacy), Dr. Shun-hwa Yu (Class of 1959, Department of Agricultural Chemistry), and Ms. Fu-mei Zheng (Class of 1964, Department of Nursing). NTU Collected Works was officially inaugurated in 2007 on the University's anniversary. It maintains archives of publications by authors associated with NTU and highlights the academic achievements of NTU faculty, staff, retirees, alumni, and current students. To date, the archive has received over 8,800 book donations from over 800 alumni.

自動化書庫服務中心



ASRS Service Center



自動化書庫位於綜合教學館地下二至四樓，是國內首次引進的設備，於2018年10月30日啟用，可典藏至少120萬冊圖書，空間利用效益高達傳統書架的5倍之多；透過自動倉儲系統控制方式，充分發揮管理效能，提供讀者省時省力之優質服務。為便利讀者使用，於該館一樓設置自動化書庫服務中心，讀者可透過館藏目錄系統線上預約，接獲取件通知後即可至自動化書庫服務中心取書。

The first-ever ASRS for libraries in Taiwan, located at floors B2 to B4 of Zonghe Lecture Building on the NTU campus, has been in operation since 2018. This system can store at least 1.2 million books, five times greater than the capacity of a traditional shelf. It efficiently saves users' time accessing library collections with its automatic management system. Users can request items through the Library online catalog and pick them up in the Service Center on the 1st floor of Zonghe Lecture Building.



Koo Chen-Fu Memorial Library 社會科學院辜振甫先生紀念圖書館

社會科學院辜振甫先生紀念圖書館（以下簡稱社科圖）原為徐州路校區法律暨社會科學院圖書分館（簡稱法社分館），2014 年隨著社會科學院自徐州路遷回校總區，而搬遷至現址，並於同年 9 月 15 日正式開放啟用。館藏整併徐州路校區的法律政治研究圖書室及經濟學研究所圖書室之館藏資源。為便利讀者使用，於 2021 年再陸續將徐州路舊法社分館館藏搬遷至圖書館自動化書庫。目前社科圖館藏約計 21 萬 7 千餘冊，其中承接日治時期臺灣總督府臺北高等商業學校及臺北帝國大學文政學部政學科所藏日治時期法政、經濟與東南亞研究之圖書與期刊是為珍貴特色館藏，計約 10 萬冊。

The Koo Chen-Fu Memorial Library opened on September 15, 2014, when the College of Social Sciences relocated to its new building on the Main Campus. The Library aims to support teaching and research in the College of Social Sciences and to bolster academic achievements. The physical collections consolidate the holdings at the Law and Political Science Research Library, the Graduate Institute of Economics Library, and part of the original Law and Social Sciences Library at the Downtown Campus. For users' convenience, holdings at the original Law and Social Sciences Library have been transferring to the ASRS Service Center since 2021. Hence, the Koo Chen-Fu Memorial Library has more than 217,000 volumes of the collection. Featured collections total around 100,000 books and journals of law, politics, economics, and Southeast Asian studies during the Japanese colonial period.

社會科學院大樓由日本知名建築家伊東豐雄建築師設計。社科圖位於中央樓層的地下一樓至二樓部分空間，面積 4,645 平方公尺，最具特色者為由 88 支樹狀柱結構屋頂與 130 個形狀不一的天窗造型，搭配竹製書架及桌椅，所打造宛如森林般的一樓開架閱覽空間。社科院遷院計畫歷經 12 年籌備，再經過 4 年半的興建與搬遷，為感謝校友辜振甫學長生前及其家族對大樓興建及圖書館裝修慷慨捐款，本校特將社科院圖書館空間命名為「辜振甫先生紀念圖書館」，以茲感念。

The new College of Social Sciences building was designed by the famous Japanese architect Toyo Ito. The Library is located at the center of the building, from B1 to the 2nd floor, with an area of 4,645 square meters. The open shelf area on the 1st floor is one of the most uniquely designed sections—supported by 88 white columns designed to imitate trees with 130 irregularly shaped skylights, with stacked bamboo bookshelves and furniture that make one feel as if they are reading in a tranquil forest. The relocation of the College of Social Sciences took 12 years to plan, followed by four and a half years of construction and moving. The University named the Library Koo Chen-Fu Memorial Library in dedication to alumnus Koo Chen-Fu for his and his family's generous donations to the project.

社科圖以成為國內社會科學研究重鎮為目標，以支援社會科學院教學、研究需求，厚植學術能量為業務核心。學科館員針對社會科學院所屬政治系、經濟系、社會系、社工系、國發所、新聞所、公事所等系所師生之教學、研究與學習需求，提供深度學科諮詢、教育訓練、展示推廣等服務和活動。

The Library seeks to become the hub of social sciences research in Taiwan. The subject librarians here provide reference services, library instruction, and extension services for the Departments of Political Science, Economics, Sociology, and Social Work, and the Graduate Institutes of National Development, Journalism, and Public Affairs.

國立臺灣大學醫學圖書館（以下簡稱醫圖）為國內歷史最悠久且館藏最豐富之醫學圖書館，其發軔可追溯至 1899 年 4 月，時稱「臺灣總督府醫學校圖書室」，1936 年改稱「臺北帝國大學附屬圖書館醫學部分室」，1945 年臺灣光復，更名為「國立臺灣大學醫學院圖書分館」，1989 年 4 月遷至現址，1991 年 2 月臺大醫院圖書室與醫圖合併，1992 年 11 月及 1994 年 7 月護理系及公共衛生學院先後將其圖書資料移至醫圖。醫圖肩負提供醫學校區醫學資訊與服務之責，主要服務對象為本校醫學院、公衛學院之教職員工生及臺大醫院之醫護人員，服務人數逾 1 萬 3 千人，同時亦開放予校外讀者使用。2018 年 2 月更名為「國立臺灣大學醫學圖書館」。

The National Taiwan University Medical Library (NTUML) is the oldest medical library with the largest medical collection in Taiwan. Founded in April 1899, it was originally named "Medical School Library of the Taiwan Governor-General's Office." The library was merged with Taihoku Imperial University in 1936 and renamed "Medical Branch of Taihoku Imperial University Library." In 1945, the Library changed its name to "Medical Branch of National Taiwan University Library" after Taiwan's liberation from Japanese rule, and moved to its current location in April 1989. After combining collections with the Medical School Affiliated Hospital Library in February 1991, with the School of Nursing in November 1992, and with the College of Public Health in July 1994, the Medical Branch became the medical information service center for the Medical Campus, serving more than 13,000 patrons, including those from the University, NTU Hospital, and the public. In February 2018, it was renamed "National Taiwan University Medical Library."



醫圖館藏旨在支援及配合本校醫學校區之教學、研究與醫療服務，以健康科學相關資料為主要蒐藏範圍，資料類型包括圖書、期刊、視聽資料與電子資源等，目前館藏量已達 12 萬冊以上，並設有 RFID 自助借還書機，增加讀者借還書之便利性。為提昇校區同仁之人文素養、培養學生的人文關懷，醫圖特設有醫學人文區，專架陳列臺灣醫療史、臺灣醫界人物傳記、醫學與人文等主題之相關資料。此外，亦定期舉辦各項活動以推廣館藏與服務。

The Medical Library aims to support the teaching, research, and healthcare services of the faculty and students of the Medical Campus. Thus, the Library collection focuses on health sciences and related subjects, holding more than 120,000 volumes of books, journals, audiovisual materials, and electronic resources. The RFID system in this library is convenient for users to borrow and return books by themselves. The Medical Humanities Area, with collections on Taiwan's medical history and biographies of Taiwan medical professionals, fosters humanistic literacy and humanistic concerns of faculty and students. Moreover, library tours, educational instruction, and many other activities are held at the Medical Library to promote its collection and services.

2017 年起展開首次大規模的空間改造，以促進校區師生腦力激盪與交流為理念，規劃內容為：2019 年釋出一樓部分空間設置咖啡廳，提供舒適宜人的環境與美味餐點；2020 年完成二樓學習開放空間，備有多元資訊設備與討論場地；2022 年完成四樓閱讀沉思區及自習室，供個人化學習研究之用。改造後的醫學圖書館為一活用的有機體，將可適度滿足師生同仁的多元需求。

The Medical Library was remodeled comprehensively for the first time in 2017 based on the philosophy of encouraging brainstorming and communication among faculty and students. There were three phases in the remodeling plan. First, a café on the 1st floor was introduced in 2019 to offer a comfortable ambiance and refreshments. Second, a Learning Commons on the 2nd floor, with various information devices and discussion areas, was opened in 2020. Third, the library completed the NTUer Lounge and study rooms on the 4th floor for individual learning in 2022. Overall, the renovation turned the Medical Library into a lively and delightful environment to fulfill faculty and students' needs.

Others



法律學院圖書館

Law Library

法律學院圖書館（以下簡稱法律圖），於 2009 年 7 月隨著法律學院由徐州路校區搬遷至校總區，設立於法律學院萬才館一、二樓，總面積約 1,365 平方公尺。2016 年富邦集團蔡萬才家族贊助本棟建築物改造裝修，包括教室與圖書館櫃臺的改裝、增設密集書庫區、更新監視系統，以及將特藏室改造為法學典範書屋等，2022 年改裝兩間討論室，新增無線投影及電子白板設備，打造法律圖為一與時俱進的優質學習空間，以支援法律學院之師生教學研究，並協助臺灣法學教育的永續發展。

館藏整併原徐州路法社分館與法政研圖之重要法律類藏書與期刊，截至目前，計有圖書及裝訂期刊總計逾 6 萬冊，並典藏中、日、英、法、德之法學專業相關紙本期刊 180 種。

樓層配置一樓為期刊、參考書、博碩士論文、人權資料專區、中日文圖書、中文重要教科書區、密集書庫區，以及法學典範書屋，二樓為西文圖書區，全館總計提供 252 個閱覽席位。

The Law Library moved to Wan Tsai Research Hall with the College of Law from the Downtown Campus in July 2009, and is located on the 1st and 2nd floor, with an area of 1,365 square meters. In 2016, the Wan-Tsai Tsai family (Fubon Group) sponsored the renovation of the research hall to reconstruct classrooms and improve the functionality of the Library, such as rebuilding the service

desk, extending the compact stacks area, updating the monitoring system, and remodeling the Featured Collection Area to the Bookhouse of Paradigms in Law. In 2022, two discussion rooms were renovated for supporting wireless projection and digital whiteboards. Establishing such an up-to-date learning space is beneficial for supporting teaching and research activities in the College of Law and advancing law education in Taiwan.

The Library holdings consolidate essential collections in the legal discipline from the former Law and Social Sciences Library and the Law and Political Science Research Library. To date, there are over 60,000 volumes of books and bound periodicals along with 180 different titles of printed journals.

The journals, reference books, dissertations, theses, human rights materials, Chinese and Japanese books, major Chinese textbooks, compact stacks, and the Bookhouse of Paradigms in Law are located on the 1st floor. Western language books are on the 2nd floor. There are 252 reading seats in the Law Library.

其他系所圖書室

Departmental Libraries

由於校區分散及歷史淵源，目前除總圖書館、社科圖、醫圖、法律圖外，尚有數學、物理、化學、海洋與圖書資訊等系所圖書室。

Due to its historical background and dispersed campuses, there are also departmental libraries for Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Oceanography, and Library & Information Science.





館藏

Collections

本館館藏以配合校內師生教學研究需要為主，館藏量逐年增加，迄今已逾 840 萬冊 / 件，為國內收藏資料量最多的大學圖書館。此外，亦為我國政府出版品寄存圖書館之一，並與多個國家地區的學術及研究機構維持出版品交換贈送關係，達到促進校際、國際學術交流之目的。

The mission of NTU Library is to fulfill the teaching, learning, and research needs of students and faculty at the University. To date, the Library houses more than 8,400,000 items, which makes NTU Library the largest academic library in Taiwan.

To facilitate inter-collegiate and international academic communication, NTU Library is one of the officially designated repositories for government publications and has agreements for exchange and donation with academic and research institutes worldwide.

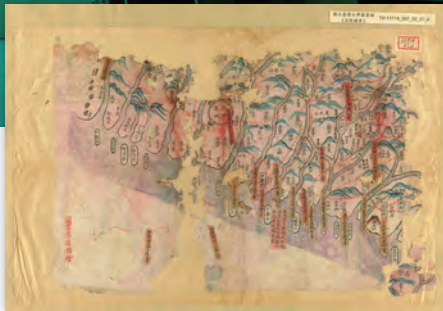


特藏資源

Special Collections

圖書館收藏中外文古籍善本資料 25 萬餘件，為國內各大學之最，如淡新檔案、明版線裝書、琉球歷代寶案、西洋搖籃期刊本等均至為珍貴。此外，本校教授與校友不乏近代名家，本館主動蒐集手稿真跡，提供優質保存環境，並擴及至非本校之其他名家手稿，以落實本校研究資源重鎮之譽。

NTU Library holds over 250,000 volumes of rare books in Chinese and other languages, particularly the Tan-Hsin Archive (1776-1895) (judiciary archive of Tamsui and Hsinchu area), Ming editions of thread-bound books (from the 15th to 16th century), the Rekidai Hoan (1424-1867) (diplomatic archive of the Ryūkyū Kingdom), and the collection of 15th-century European incunabula. It is the largest of such holdings of any academic library in Taiwan. The Library has also actively acquired manuscripts from the University's faculty, alumni, and non-NTU notable persons to establish such a resource hub.



本校前身為日治時期之臺北帝國大學，建校初期便建立極具地域特色之講座與研究所，從事臺灣、中國大陸及南洋等亞洲地區有關歷史、自然、產業、資源等各方面之調查和研究，其中因臺灣資料館藏之豐富多元，為臺灣資料重要的典藏機構。本館目前仍持續以臺灣研究為收藏重點，廣泛蒐集圖書、期刊、檔案手稿及相關影音資料等。

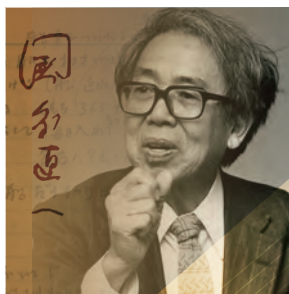
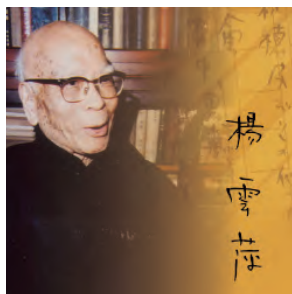
NTU's predecessor, Taihoku Imperial University, was a pioneer institution for study on Taiwan, Mainland China, and Southeast Asia. A chair system was established for historical, natural, industrial, and resource research in area studies. The rich and diverse collections of Taiwan have especially made the Library an essential archival institution for such research materials. In hopes of enriching the Library's Taiwan Studies materials, the Library continues to focus on acquiring books, journals, archives, manuscripts, and multimedia materials in the field.

本館自 1997 年起推動館藏數位化工作，近 20 年來已有相當成績。藉由前國科會國家型科技計畫，已完成淡新檔案、臺灣古碑拓本、伊能嘉矩手稿、田代安定手稿、歌仔冊、狄寶賽文庫等臺灣研究資源數位化；其他中日西文善本、檔案手稿、珍貴影音資料等館藏，亦逐步透過數位化，兼顧保存與推廣利用之效。臺灣舊照片資料庫與日治時期統計資料庫，從日治時期舊籍中摘取元素，創造新的特色館藏。本館亦積極與校外典藏單位、私人收藏家合作數位化，包含中國國民黨史料、慈林教育基金會典藏之臺灣社運史料等都有豐碩成果。

近年著重各特藏文庫及手稿數位化，包含磯永吉、楊雲萍、國分直一、葉嘉瑩、林文月、白先勇、葉俊麟、慎芝／關華石之手稿、小川文庫、大鳥文庫、田中文庫及杜聰明文庫之特色圖書等，上述數位化資料均可於本館網站「特藏資源」頁籤下查詢瀏覽。

Since 1997, the Library has been endorsing digitization of its collections and has had much progress in the last 20 years. Through the National Science Council's (now the National Science and Technology Council) National Technology Program, Taiwanese research materials such as the Tan-Hsin Archives, the Monumental Stone Rubbings, Manuscripts of Kanori Ino, the Tashiro Antei Manuscripts, Kua-a-tsheh (lyric books of Taiwanese Opera), the V. S. de Beausset Collection, and others have been completely digitalized. For better preservation, promotion, and use, the Library has been digitizing its rare books, manuscript collections, and audio-visual records continuously. For instance, the creation of the Database of Taiwanese Old Photos and the Taiwan Colonial Statistics Database shows the Library's efforts toward reorganizing featured characteristics from books published during the Japanese Era (1895-1945) and coining novel special collections. On the other hand, the Library also seeks collaboration with other institutions and private collectors, including the KMT Party History Database and the Taiwan Democracy Archives held by the Chilin Foundation.

In recent years, the focus of digitization has shifted to personal collections, such as the manuscripts of Eikichi Iso, Yun-Ping Yang, Naoichi Kokubu, Chia-Ying Yeh, Wen-Yueh Lin, Hsien-Yung Pai, Jun-Lin Ye, and Shen-Chih/Hua-Shih Kuan, as well as rare books from the Ogawa Collection, Otori Collection, Tanaka Collection, and Tsung-Ming Tu Collection. Users are able to retrieve these featured collections on the Library website.



服務 Services

書刊 流通

Circulation Services

本館多數館藏以開架方式陳列供讀者利用，一般圖書均可外借，期刊、報紙、參考資料、特藏資料及公播版視聽資料則以館內閱覽為主。為方便讀者還書，所借圖書可歸還至總圖、社科圖、醫圖及任一院、系所圖書室；為服務本校讀者借用跨校區圖書資料，圖書館亦提供校內圖書代借服務，專任教師更可選擇到館取件或傳送至系所辦公室。

The NTU Library maintains open stacks in most areas (except for the 5th floor of the Main Library). Although books can be checked out, other items such as journals, newspapers, reference collection materials, special collections, and public presentation editions of audiovisual materials are for in-library use only. For readers' convenience, books can be returned at any branch/departmental library. Additionally, the Intercampus Loan Service is provided for readers to request books between the libraries on the Main Campus and the Medical Library; full-time faculty may further choose to obtain requested books at the Library or a departmental office.

館際 合作

Interlibrary Loan Services

凡本館未收藏之資料，讀者可透過館際合作服務向國內外圖書館申請複印或借閱。本館加入國內館際合作系統—「全國文獻傳遞服務系統 (Nationwide Document Delivery Service, 簡稱 NDDS)」，以協助讀者向國內其他單位申請；另可透過 OCLC、Rapid ILL 或國外其他單位，取得國內未蒐藏之資料。目前本館與國內 100 餘所大專院校簽訂圖書互借協議，讀者可向本館洽借該單位核發之借書證前往借書。多年來，本館受理國內外機構提出之館際複印與借書申請案件，年服務量常居全國之冠。

為增進本校與國立臺灣師範大學、國立臺灣科技大學三校圖書資源服務合作與交流，推出「三校借書一卡通用服務」，申辦通過後三校師生可持教職員工證或學生證至合作館借閱圖書或使用閱覽服務。

Books and documents not held at NTU libraries can be checked out from other libraries in Taiwan through the Nationwide Document Delivery Service (NDDS) or acquired internationally from OCLC, Rapid ILL, and other institutions. In addition, the Library has interlibrary loan agreements with over 100 academic libraries in Taiwan. Users may check out books from those libraries by applying for a library card at the circulation desk or via the online interlibrary loan system. The annual number of requests for materials from the NTU Library collection is perennially ranked the highest in Taiwan.

National Taiwan University, National Taiwan Normal University, and National Taiwan University of Science and Technology have introduced the Tri-Library Loan Service so that eligible patrons at the three universities may use their university IDs to check out books from the other two university's libraries.

參考 諮詢

Reference Services

本館由專業館員提供參考諮詢服務，回復讀者有關圖書館服務與資源使用等諮詢，並指導讀者查找與蒐集研究資料。另提供本校師生專屬「與館員有約」深度諮詢服務，能更深入了解本館豐富多元的資源，獲得更精準的客製化資訊。除面對面的服務外，也可透過電話、電子郵件或圖書館臉書粉絲專頁等方式提出問題，或從本館網頁與參考服務部落格取得各種資訊新知與指引。

NTU Library provides Reference Services with professional subject librarians, including guiding patrons on using library services and resources and instruction on searching and organizing research materials. To further understand and utilize the Library's plentiful resources, faculty and students can book "Ask a Librarian" for an in-depth consultation and obtain personalized information. Other than face-to-face services, users may raise questions and get answers via phone, email, or Facebook. The NTU Library website and Reference Service Blog are also effective ways of acquiring numerous types of information and instruction.



學科 服務

Subject Services

本館學科館員秉持便捷、熱忱、學習、專業（Handy、Enthusiastic、Learning、Professional，簡稱 HELP）的服務信念，提供教師與學生教學支援、研究和學習協助等專業服務，不僅擔任院系所與圖書館之間的聯繫窗口，協助教師辦理課程指定參考資料、研擬計畫用書與專業書刊推薦，瞭解師生需求以協助其研提相關研究計畫，並提供客製化的學科主題利用指導講習。

為能永續典藏並呈現本校學術研究產能，2018 年整合本校機構典藏（NTUR）與學術庫（Academic Hub）二平臺，於 9 月份推出臺大學術典藏（NTU Scholars，<https://scholars.lib.ntu.edu.tw>），透過研究者簡歷、研究成果之資料連結、以及多元學術影響力指標的提供，加值呈現學術合作之網絡趨勢，並永久典藏本校學術成果。

NTU Library subject librarians uphold the core belief of HELP (Handy, Enthusiastic, Learning, and Professional) to support NTUers' teaching, learning, and research activities. Subject librarians bridge departments/colleges and the Library, assisting professors in managing course reserve books, drafting bibliographies for projects, and recommending books and journals in specific academic fields. They also help professors and students to construct research projects and customize instructional classes in different subjects.

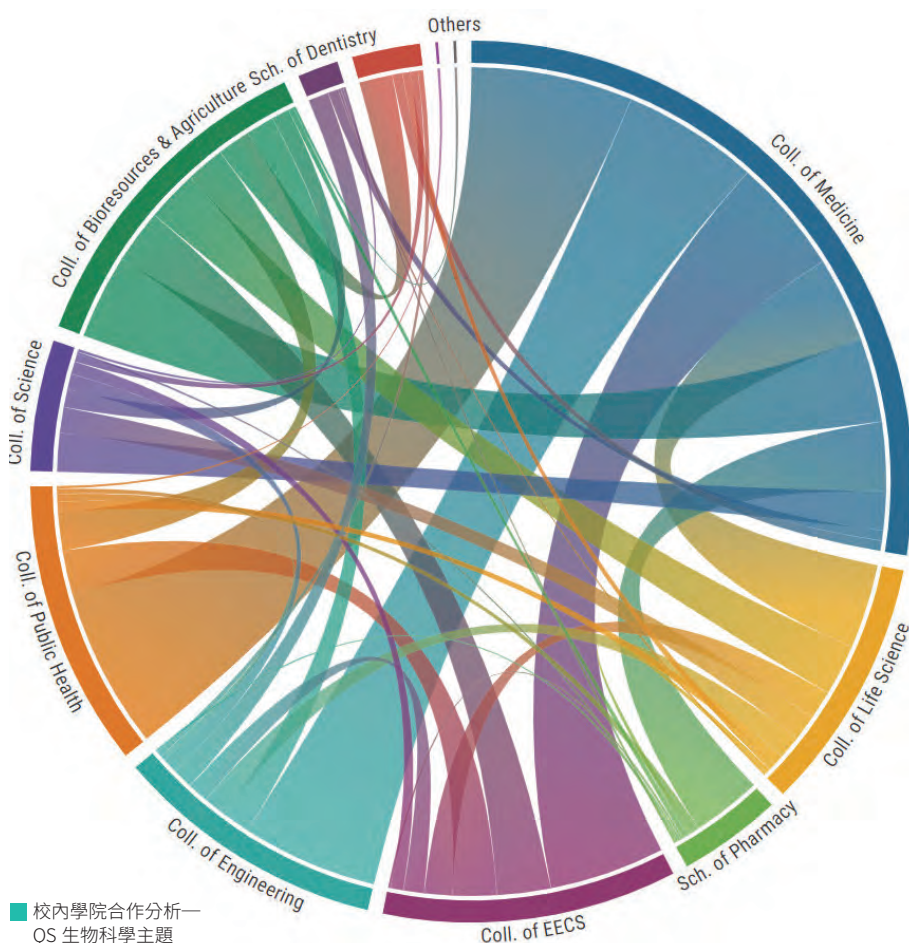
To sustainably archive and present the academic productivity of NTU, the Library integrated the NTU Repository and Academic Hub into "NTU Scholars" (<https://scholars.lib.ntu.edu.tw>) on September 2018. In addition to consolidating researchers' portfolios and their works, NTU Scholars provides numerous academic impact indicators to show trends in cooperation among disciplines and preserve the academic achievements of the University.

研究 支援

Research Support Services

本館於 2018 年設置「研究支援組」，專責支援校內教師及單位之學術研究相關工作。針對教師及院系所提供的領域網絡分析服務（Domain Network Analysis Service，簡稱 DNA 服務），係利用大型引文資料庫如 Web of Science 核心合輯及 SCOPUS 等，藉由書目計量、資料探勘等方法，透過共同關鍵字、共著、共引及書目耦合等引文網絡關係，取徑社會網絡分析與資訊視覺化等方法呈現研究主題之消長，協助其辨識研究典範之移轉並探索新興研究前沿（Research Front）；此外，同時協助研究單位概觀其學術產出的聚焦熱點、分析合作走向、掌握全球領域發展現況，提供單位進行學術研究方向規劃決策之重要參考，提升機構之整體學術研究力。

The Research Support Division was established in 2018 to assist NTU faculty and units in academic research. The Domain Network Analysis (DNA) Service provides faculty and academic units services to utilize data analysis and bibliomining methods in citation index databases such as Web of Science and SCOPUS to construct networks of co-keywords, co-authors, co-citations, and bibliographic coupling to present changes of research subjects through social network analysis and information visualization. This is beneficial for applicants to acknowledge paradigm shifts and explore the Research Front. In addition, with the services provided by Research Support Division, University academic units may comprehensively recognize the foci of the disciplines, analyze cooperation trends, and identify current global domains, which are important references for decision-making in research planning. Such services may also enhance the academic competitiveness of the University.



多媒體 服務

Multimedia Services

本館多媒體館藏包含 BD、DVD、VCD、CD、黑膠唱片等國內外具教育性與知識性之各類型視聽資料，以支援教師教學研究及學生學習；另一方面，定期製作音樂主題介紹及由專業影評人針對電影館藏撰寫專文介紹，以深入淺出的方式為讀者提供不同角度的欣賞觀點，行銷多媒體館藏。相關服務包括：影音@Online 系統、影音 Focus、主題影片選介、數位學習、視聽資料借閱及團體室借用等服務。

Multimedia collections in the Library are used for teaching, research, and learning activities, and consist of various types of educational audiovisual materials such as Blu-ray, DVDs, VCDs, CDs, and gramophone records. Periodically, the librarians introduce different types of music, and film critics write columns to promote collections by offering different perspectives. Related services include the Information on Demand system, blogs for film and music, recommendations for thematic movies, e-learning facilities and programs, multimedia collection circulation, media hub and group learning room reservation.



資訊 服務

Information Services

2018年本館導入雲端圖書館自動化系統（System for Library Information Management，簡稱 SLIM），透過雲端服務架構與嶄新介面，改善圖書館各項服務的內部作業流程，有效管理實體與電子館藏、加強系統與資源整合，以提供讀者端一鍵式整合查詢功能，有效率地取得館藏資源。

本館亦自行開發新版「國立臺灣大學圖書館行動 APP」（iOS、Android）及 LINE 官方帳號應用，使讀者更便利地使用圖書館服務與資源，隨時掌握圖書館最新消息、館藏查詢、個人續借與預約等服務，也能於行動裝置上瀏覽精彩影評、試聽經典音樂、讀取館內 AR 擴增實境等多媒體內容。

NTU Library introduced the System for Library Information Management (SLIM) in 2018 to improve internal workflows through a cloud-based service structure and a novel interface. SLIM is beneficial for managing both printed and electronic collections and strengthening the consolidation of systems and resources, providing a one-click discovery service for users to obtain collection materials effectively.

The Library also developed the NTUL Mobile APP for both iOS and Android users to access services and resources more conveniently. Users may check the latest news, retrieve and request materials, renew borrowed items, browse film reviews, listen to music trailers, and have AR experiences within the APP. Moreover, users may activate a mobile ID and enjoy several of the above features by adding the Library's LINE Official Account.



推廣 服務

Extension Services

為增進讀者對圖書館館藏與服務之利用、拓展讀者視野、提升圖書館形象，本館經常舉辦各種推廣活動，如展覽、參觀導覽、演講座談、互動遊戲、資源利用課程等，引領讀者貼近本館內涵、培養其自我學習、思考之能力與素養。並受理參訪交流行程、編製各式文宣簡介與出版品，供校內外讀者瞭解本館營運概況，有助於建立良好公共關係並行銷本館專業形象。此外，亦致力於經營網站、電子報、社群媒體等多種傳播媒介，便利讀者獲得最即時的訊息與服務動態。

In order to promote the services and resources of NTU Library, numerous extension activities such as exhibitions, lectures and talks, interactive games, book exhibitions, film festivals, and topical instruction programs have been held for drawing patrons' attention and developing their independent learning ability and literacy. In addition, the Library conducts public relations and markets its professional image by arranging tours for patrons from various fields and publishing brochures and manuals. NTU Library also operates websites and writes e-newsletters and social media content to provide the public with instant information.





校史館 / 博物館群

NTU History Gallery / NTU Museums

本館於 1998 年啟用新館後，同年舊總圖由臺北市政府指定為古蹟，並於 2005 年 6 月成立校史館，坐落舊總圖書館二樓中央閱覽室。校史館設立後，廣泛徵集校史文物、老照片，並進行口述訪談，策劃校史記憶相關特展與活動，延續本校記憶、凝聚向心力並傳承其精神。

2007 年 11 月起啟動「臺大博物館群」，由圖書館負責規劃整合全校 11 個標本室或小型博物館（人類、動物、植物、昆蟲、地質、醫學人文、物理、農業、校史、檔案、美術館籌備處）。目前博物館群辦公室設置於校史館營運組，負責博物館群統籌性行政業務與推廣活動，2019 年起獲得校方支持，推動校級博物館籌備，建立跨學科交流、多元對話平臺，實踐知識與文化平權，持續為大學的社會教育責任善盡心力。

When NTU Main Library moved to its current location and opened in 1998, the older building was designated as a municipal monument. In June 2005, the Central Reading Room on the 2nd floor of the old Main Library building was reconstructed and formally opened as the NTU History Gallery. To build coherence and embrace the philosophy of NTU, the NTU History Gallery not only extensively collects historical relics and oral histories related to the University, but also curates various exhibitions and holds activities to honor NTU history.

The NTU Museums Plan was launched by the University in November 2007 for making educational impacts on society. NTU Library has been in charge of planning, coordinating, managing, and promoting the affairs of the 11 members of the NTU Museums Group, which include the Museum of Anthropology, the Zoology Museum, the TAI Herbarium, the Insect Museum, the Geology Museum, the Museum of Medical Humanities, the Heritage Hall of Physics, the Agricultural Exhibition Hall, the NTU History Gallery, the Museum of Archives, and the Art Museum (in preparation). Currently, the headquarters of NTU Museums is located at the office of the University History Affairs Division of NTU Library, where staff preside over joint administrative matters and extension activities. Furthermore, a project for university-level museum establishment was started in 2019 to envision a platform for interdisciplinary communication, knowledge equity, and cultural inclusion.

臺灣原住民族 圖書資訊中心

本館受原住民族委員會之委託，自 2006 年起於總圖地下一樓建置並營運「臺灣原住民族圖書資訊中心」，以專門圖書館為定位，致力於徵集與整理國內外原住民族相關議題的研究資源，提供讀者閱覽利用。資料類型包含中文、日文、外文圖書、多媒體影音資料與電子資源，持續發展館藏內容的深度及廣度。至 2022 年，原圖中心收錄館藏量已逾 4 萬 5 千冊（件）。

原圖中心除典藏實體資料，也同步建置臺灣原住民族資訊資源網，廣泛蒐集原住民族各類活動消息、實體資源目錄、研究資源，以及網路上原住民族相關數位資源，加以分類整理，提供原住民族群主題服務入口平臺，並應用資訊網路通訊等科技技術，促使資訊流通迅速。

As part of a project commissioned by the Council of Indigenous Peoples, NTU Library established the Taiwan Indigenous Peoples Resource Center at B1 of the Main Library in 2006, which is a special library for acquiring and organizing resources about Taiwan indigenous peoples and other indigenous peoples of the world for visitors. The Center collects materials of various languages and types, including books in Chinese, Japanese, and other foreign languages, multimedia collections, and e-resources. As of 2022, the Center held nearly 45,000 volumes.

Besides physical holdings, this Center also dedicates itself to maintaining the website Taiwan Indigenous Peoples Portal to collect and organize relevant events, catalogs of print collections, academic resources, and various other kinds of information.

1995年成立的「佛學數位圖書館（以下簡稱佛圖）」，<https://buddhism.lib.ntu.edu.tw/>由本校哲學系榮退教授釋恆清法師肇創，2003年由本館接手營運，至2009年改由本校文學院執行，2018年4月起再度由本館接續承辦，本校資訊工程學系特聘教授暨數位人文中心主任項潔教授自2003年起擔任主持人至今。佛圖致力於蒐集匯整全球佛教研究文獻與經典，2017年獲選全球百大大學數位圖書館之一，目前全球使用量每日逾1萬人次，總使用量超過4千萬人次，現為全球最大線上佛學研究主題資料庫，獲得全球各大學所推薦。

佛圖收藏逾48萬篇書目資訊、13萬多篇全文檔案，內容包括全球47種語言以及15種資料類型，使用者可進行檢索，並免費閱讀下載。可利用「佛學學者規範資料庫」查詢全球11萬名佛學研究者的相關著作目錄、及透過「收錄期刊指南」查詢全球逾3,000種佛教期刊。亦提供2萬卷數位佛典下載，以及線上梵文、藏文、巴利文等語言教學工具。

The Digital Library of Buddhist Studies (DLMBs, <https://buddhism.lib.ntu.edu.tw/>) was founded in 1995 by Professor Emeritus of the Department of Philosophy Ven. Shih Hen-ching. Sponsorship was transferred to NTU Library in 2003 until 2009, when the College of Liberal Arts took over. Sponsorship was then given back to the Library in 2018. The Principal Investigator of the project since 2003 has been Jieh Hsiang, Distinguished Professor of the Department of Computer Science and Information Engineering and Director of the Research Center for Digital Humanities. DLMBs focuses on collecting bibliographies and full texts of journal articles and books, as well as collections of essays and other research resources in Buddhist studies. It was selected as one of the 100 Extensive University Libraries from Around the World that Anyone Can Access by CollegeDegree.com in 2017, and is the only one on Buddhist Studies. It is the most comprehensive database of its kind in the field of Buddhist studies and is recommended by universities worldwide. The website currently has more than 40,000,000 total hits.

The current content of DLMBs includes more than 480,000 bibliographic records and 130,000 full texts in 47 languages, as well as 15 types of literature. The new Buddhist Author Authority Database allows users to search the works of 110,000 of the world's Buddhist researchers, and the Journals Included section enables users to search over 3,000 Buddhist journals. It also provides 20,000 volumes of digital Buddhist canons for users to download and online teaching tools for Sanskrit, Tibetan, Pali, and other languages.

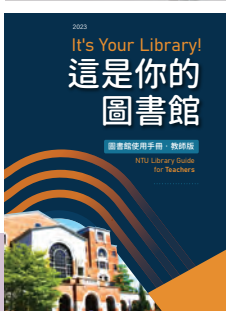

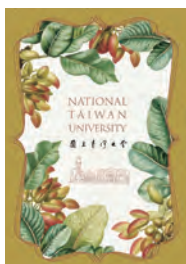
