OPEN CLASS/FFA SHOWS

- DATE:** Saturday, August 3, 2024
- TIME & LOCATION:** **MEAT:** Old Show Arena @ 11:00 AM
DAIRY to follow
- FORMAT:** FFA & Open Class Shows occur concurrently.
- SHOW RULES:**
- 1) An animal CANNOT compete in both 4-H & FFA.
 - 2) Dairy classes will be shown by breed only if more than 3 exhibitors and 7 animals of that breed.
 - 3) **No trailering in for show day.**
 - 4) Only one entry in each group lot per exhibitor

OPEN CLASS ENTRIES

PRE-REGISTER: All Open Class animals must PRE-REGISTER by JULY 20. In order to earn PREMIUM

IDENTIFICATION/HEALTH

IDENTIFICATION TAGS: All animals will be checked for proper identification. Any animal without proper identification will be required to leave the fairgrounds, and the animal will not be eligible for competition or premium.

*Proper identification outlined on pages 22-25.

HEALTH CHECK: All goats will be examined by the official veterinarian. NO WARTS or RINGWORM.

No animals within 30 days of giving birth or less than 30 days of age.

ANIMAL ARRIVAL

ARRIVAL TIME: Goats are allowed onto the fairgrounds starting on Wednesday, July 31. Goats must be in place by 7:00 AM on Thursday, Aug. 1.

RELEASE TIME: Goats will be released no sooner than **6:00 PM on Sunday.**

PENNING: Exhibitors are required to clean and fold panels up the last night of the fair.

TRAILERS: All livestock trailers must enter the fairgrounds through the **North Gate**. When leaving the grounds, trailers can exit through the **South Gate** or the **Northwest Gate** (see map).

*Trailers can park in field across from the West Gate during the fair for no charge.
