**LIMITS:** Each member will be limited to **ONE** entry per individual lot. *EXCEPT:* livestock, which will be limited to **TWO** entries per lot (only 1 entry for group lots). Only animals, which are projects of members, and on which records are kept as, certified by their FFA advisor, can be exhibited in FFA classes.

**PRE-REGISTER:** All FFA animals must PRE-REGISTER by **JULY 20. In order to earn PREMIUM**

**ENTRY DAY:** All non-livestock and children's barnyard entries must arrive from 2-5 PM on Wednesday, July 31.

**LIVESTOCK:** All animal exhibits must comply with the rules and regulations of the MN Board of Animal Health. \*\*See pages 29-31.

**OPEN CLASS/4-H/FFA:** An animal that competes in a 4-H Show CANNOT compete in FFA, but it can compete in Open Class.

- HAY** shall be shown as a 12-inch section neatly tied.
- SILAGE, HIGH MOISTURE CORN, & HAYLAGE** will be shown as 1-gallon sample in a sealed, clear plastic bag.
- Must specify **VARIETY** on all small grain and soybean entries
