## **GENERAL RULES**

PARTICIPANTS: Open to any bona fide FFA member (7th & 8th graders are eligible).

LIMITS: Each member will be limited to ONE entry per individual lot. EXCEPT: livestock, which will be limited to TWO entries per lot (only 1 entry for group lots). Only animals, which are projects of members, and on which records are kept as, certified by their FFA advisor, can be exhibited in FFA classes.

PRE-REGISTE	R: All FFA animals <u>must</u> PRE-REGISTER by JULY 20. In order to earn PREMIUM *Use Open Class/FFA entry form (Page 25) Late registrations will NOT be accepted!
ENTRY DAY:	All non-livestock and children's barnyard entries must arrive from 2-5 PM on Wednesday, July 31. *Exhibited livestock due in barns by 7 AM Thurs., Aug. 1
LIVESTOCK:	All animal exhibits must comply with the rules and regulations of the MN Board of Animal Health. <b>**See pages 29-31.</b>

**OPEN CLASS/4-H/FFA:** An animal that competes in a 4-H Show CANNOT compete in FFA, but it can compete in Open Class.
