New Entrance/Exit H at MTR Tai Wai Station Opens Today Seamless Connection with The Wai and the Adjoining Community

The new Entrance/Exit H at MTR Tai Wai Station opens today (26 October 2023) to the service of passengers, residents and customers in the community. It provides direct access between the station's Platform 3 serving the Tuen Ma Line and The Wai, a brand-new community shopping mall atop Tai Wai Station. Together with the existing Entrance/Exit B, the purpose-built entrance/exit will reinforce the seamless connectivity between the station and the developments atop the station as part of the Corporation's mission to build and connect communities.

Since its inauguration in July 2023, The Wai has been highly acclaimed for its comprehensive living and community facilities. The latest addition to MTR Malls is strategically located atop Tai Wai Station, where the East Rail Line and Tuen Ma Line converge. There are multiple entrances/exits connecting the mall to various places including the station and Public Transport Interchange as well as two new footbridges constructed and commissioned earlier to connect major estates in the area. The easy access provides convenience for passengers, local residents and customers to travel to and from different destinations, making Tai Wai a more convenient and comfortable living space.

"The Corporation upholds the 'Rail plus Community' development concept, which utilises railway as a backbone for building sustainable communities. From an early stage of this property development project, we have planned to construct a new entrance/exit at Tai Wai Station to strengthen the connectivity between station, topside development and the community. With the opening of the new Entrance/Exit H, The Wai is fully launched to provide a more diversified and quality shopping and leisure experience for the public," said Mr David Tang, Property and International Business Director of MTR Corporation.

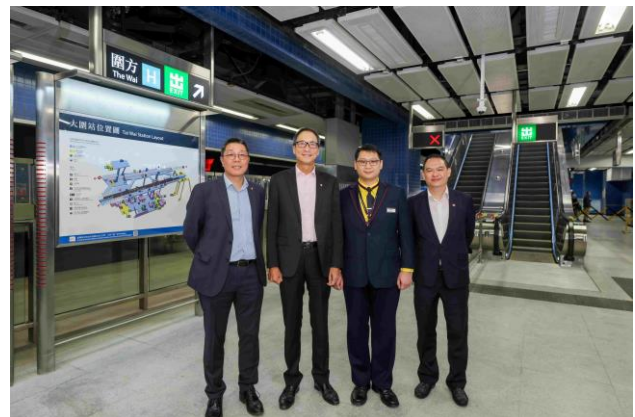
