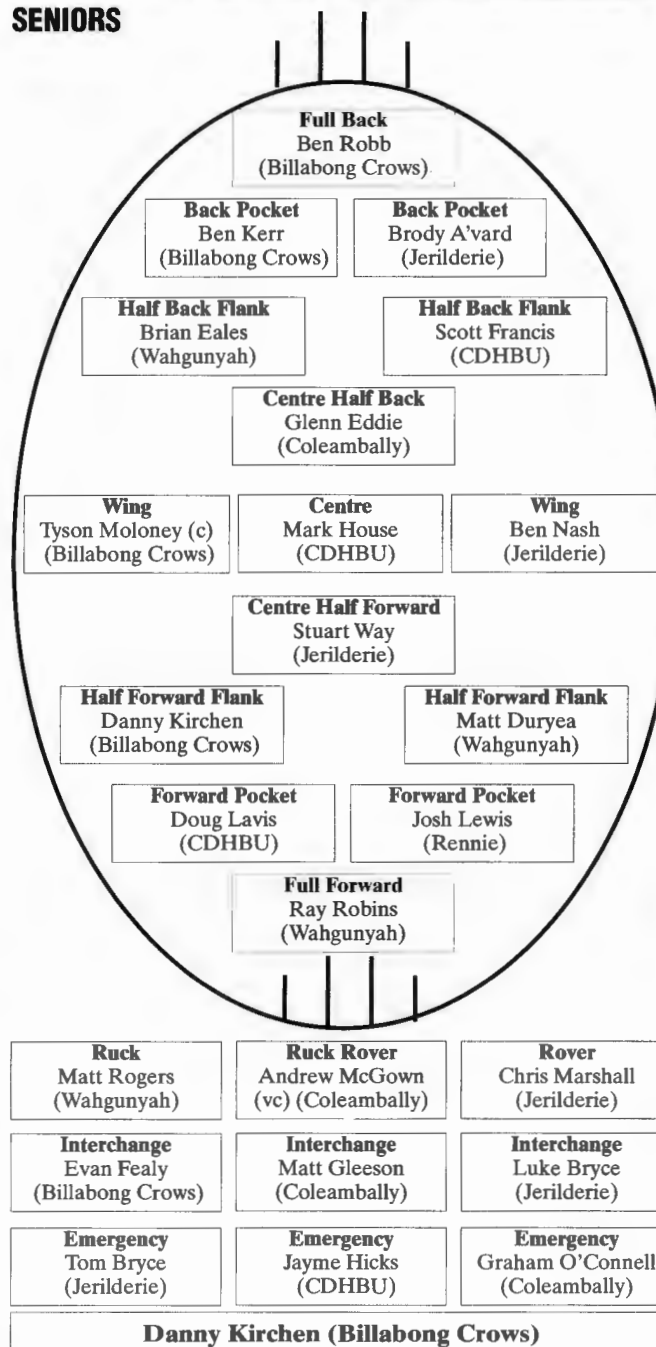

# WHERE IT ALL BEGAN!

On the 24th of April, 1909 at Matt O'Briens Buraja Hotel, a meeting was held at the request of the Coreen Football Club to try and organize an Association within the boundaries of the Corowa Shire. Clubs represented at the Meeting were Coreen Buraja, Ringwood, Redlands and Shannonvale. It was decided to form the Coreen Shire Football Association and award the Premiership to the team which finished on top of the ladder at the end of the home and away games. If two sides finished on the same amount of points, a play-off for the Premiership would be ordered. The first President was Mr T. Forge, Ringwood and the Secretary was Mr L.A. Hogg, Buraja. Ringwood won the Premiership.

Also 1909 IN June Urana, Daysdale and Oaklands formed an association called the Urana & District Association. President Mr Lamb, Urana, Secretary Mr Mundy Oaklands. Daysdale won the Premiership in this Association.

**1910** – Redlands & Shannonvale disbanded but three new Clubs, Daysdale from the Urana Assoc and two newly formed Clubs, Coreen Settlers and Buraja Village. Daysdale & Ringwood finished level on top of the ladder so a meeting of the Delegates was held and a play-off was ordered to be played at Buraja. On the day of the play-off Daysdale players & supporters turned up at Buraja but Ringwood, who did not have a Delegate at the Meeting, refused to play because they did not want to play at Buraja. At another Delegates meeting it was decided to play at Coreen and Daysdale went on to win by 16 pts.

**1911** – Ringwood dropped out of the comp but Savernake joined to keep the numbers to six. Daysdale fielded an extremely strong side winning every match to be Premiers.

**1912** – Coreen, Buraja and Savernake did not field teams this year so Oaklands was admitted making four teams in Comp. In a one sided Season Daysdale went through undefeated thus winning their fourth successive premiership, 1 in Urana & District and 3 in Coreen & District.

**1913** – Daysdale suffered heavy losses before the Season started, Jack Kuschert leaving to captain Oaklands taking his brothers Lionel & Hans. Also Will and Albert Kuschert went to play for Urana, Dick Brown & Sam Rhodes went to the Settlers. Oaklands decided to join the Lockhart Assoc and Coreen were still unable to field a team leaving only three teams in Assoc. Coreen & Daysdale A played only one game before disbanding and The Settlers went on to be Premiers.

**1914** – The association was boosted by the return of Coreen, Ringwood & Buraja and Balldale making their first appearance in the League making a League of seven. Settlers were Premiers.

**1915** – Buraja & Buraja Village amalgamated to form Lowesdale Football Clubn Ringwood & Redlands joined forces to become Redlands, Coreen could not field a team but a group of young men intending to join the Forces and based at Buraja formed Military F.C. Lowesdale & Redlands only played the first round before disbanding.

Military def Daysdale for the Premiership.

It was tough in those days to field teams and to-day we draw the Curtain on a League who has run out of Teams. Good luck in your new beginnings.
