Note: I am not related to North Korea (DPRK) at all. The information I obtained is from Red Star OS 3.0 desktop version, which can be found online.

This document is to provide some information on the most recent version of KPS 9566.

The most recent version seems to be KPS 9566-2011, since the fonts bundled in Red Star OS 3.0 include the string “2011KPS”.

Compared with the 2003 version,

- 1) there are some mapping changes (e.g., 0xA1C1: U+02BC → U+FE10 – this is a correct change, since 0xA1C1 is a vertical comma).
- 2) emphasized hangul syllables for Kim Jong-un (김정은) are added at 0xA4EE–0xA4F0.
- 3) lots of characters are added outside [\xA1-\xFE] [\xA1-\xFE].
