## POPULATION OF TEXAS BY COUNTIES AND MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS.

This bulletin, prepared under the direction of Mr. WILLIAM C. HUNT, chief statistician for population, gives the aggregate population of Texas by counties and minor civil divisions, according to the official count of the returns of the Twelfth Census, taken as of June 1, 1900.

Texas was admitted as a state December 29, 1845. Table 1 shows the population of Texas at each census from 1850 to 1900, inclusive, together with the increase by number and per cent during each decade.

The population of the state in 1900 is 3,048,710 as compared with a population in 1890 of 2,235,523, showing an increase during the last ten years of 813,187, or 36.4 per cent. In 1850, nearly five years after Texas was admitted as a state, its population was 212,592; in 1860 it had increased to 604,215, or 184.2 per cent. In the decade following, the increase was only 35.5 per cent, but in the next ten years, from 1870 to 1880, the population nearly doubled, and at each succeeding census the numerical gain has been large.

The population of Texas in 1900 is more than fourteen times as large as that given for 1850, the first census in which the population of the state appears.

The total land surface of Texas is, approximately, 262,290 square miles, the average number of persons to the square mile at the censuses of 1890 and 1900 being as follows: 1890, 8.5; 1900, 11.6.

Table 2 shows the population of Texas by counties at each census from 1850 to 1900, inclusive, while table 3, which immediately follows, shows, for each county, the increase (or decrease) by number and per cent during the ten years from 1890 to 1900.

The following territorial changes in the counties of Texas have been made since 1890: Foard organized from parts of Hardeman and Knox in 1891; Sterling organized from part of Tom Green in 1891; Buchel and Foley annexed to Brewster in 1897; and Encinal annexed to Webb in 1899.

Of the 243 counties in the state all but 14 have increased in population during the decade. The largest percentages of increase occur in the sparsely settled counties, some of which have acquired nearly all the population they now have during the last ten years, and, in such cases, the percentages of gain lose significance. Many of the more thickly populated counties show large numerical gains, 23 of these having increased more than 10,000 each.

The 14 counties which show a decrease in population are Aransas, Burnet, Gaines, Hardeman, Irion, Jeff Davis, Kinney, Lynn, McMullen, Marion, Upton, Wheeler, Wilbarger, and Zavalla.

Table 4 shows the population of Texas by minor civil divisions, so far as it was separately returned at the censuses of 1890 and 1900.

Of the 194 incorporated places 73 have more than 2,000 inhabitants, and of these 46 have less than 5,000; 16 have more than 5,000 but less than 10,000; 6 have more than 10,000 but less than 25,000; and 5 have more than 25,000, namely, San Antonio, with 53,321; Houston, with 44,633; Dallas, with 42,638; Galveston, with 37,789; and Fort Worth, with 26,688 inhabitants.

For the 5 cities which have a population in 1900 of more than 25,000, a summary is presented in table 6, showing the population of each from the first year in which it was separately stated in the census reports, to 1900, inclusive, together with the increase by number and per cent during each of the ten-year periods.

According to this summary the population of San Antonio, the largest city in the state, beginning with 3,488 in 1850, increased to 8,235 in 1860, or 136.1 per cent. For each of the four succeeding decades there has been more than a normal increase, and the present population is 53,321, or more than fifteen times what it was in 1850. The population of Houston, the second city in size, is 44,633 in 1900 as against 27,557 in 1890, representing an increase of 17,076, or 62.0 per cent, the largest rate of increase attained by any of the above named cities during the last decade. Galveston had a population in 1850 of 4,177, which increased with each decade to 37,789 in 1900, but since the census was taken the city has been partially destroyed by wind and flood. Both Dallas and Fort Worth appeared first in the census reports of 1880, the former with 10,358 inhabitants and the latter with 6,663. During the ten years from 1880 to 1890 both increased by very large percentages, but, for the last decade, by smaller percentages than any other of the cities named. The present population of each is somewhat more than four times as large as that given for 1880.
