TOTAL POPULATION, INCREASE, AND DISTRIBUTION.

Population of the state.—Texas, originally a part of Mexico, won its independence by revolution in 1835 and 1836 and continued as an independent republic until 1845, when it was annexed to the United States and admitted to the Union as the twenty-eighth state. Territory now constituting parts of New Mexico, Oklahoma, Kansas, Colorado, and a small part of Wyoming was included within the limits of the state until 1850, when its boundaries were established as at

present. According to the Fourteenth Census, taken as of January 1, 1920, its population is 4,663,228, which represents an increase of 766,686, or 19.7 per cent, since 1910. During the same period the population of the United States increased by 14.9 per cent.

The following summary shows the population of Texas from 1850 to 1920, inclusive, with the number and per cent of increase for each decade, in comparison with the per cent of increase for the United States as a whole:

Counties.—Texas has 253 counties, of which 4 are unorganized. Eight new counties have been formed from parts of 10 others and 2 counties have been organized from unorganized counties of the same names since 1910. Of the 235 counties whose boundaries have remained unchanged, 154 show increases and 80 decreases as compared with 1910, and in one county, Hockley, the population reported in 1920 is the same as that for 1910. (See Table 1.) Because of the changes in boundaries due to the formation of the new counties, it has been necessary, in preparing the maps (pp. 3 and 4) showing rates of increase and decrease in total and rural population of counties between 1910 and 1920, to make the following combinations: Brooks, Cameron, Duval, Hidalgo, Jim Hogg, Starr, Willacy, and Zapata; Culberson, El Paso, and Hudspeth; Jim Wells, Kleberg, and Nueces; Bandera, Edwards, Kerr, and Real.

Density of population.—The total land area of the state is 262,398 square miles. The average number of inhabitants to the square mile in 1920 is 17.8 (see Table 1), as against 14.8 in 1910 and 11.6 in 1900.

Minor civil divisions.—The political units into which the counties are divided are collectively termed "minor civil divisions." The 249 organized counties of Texas are made up of 1,582 primary divisions, comprising 1,544 justice precincts, 12 commissioners' precincts, 5 voting precincts, and 21 school districts. The secondary divisions, 455 in number, comprise 171 cities, 276 towns (including 1—Toyah, in Reeves County—not returned separately in 1920), and 8 villages. Two cities and 1 town are coextensive with the precincts in which located, and each of 6 cities and 3 towns comprises 2 or more precincts or parts of precincts. (See Table 2.)

POPULATION—TEXAS.

Cities.—Texas has 171 cities, of which San Antonio, with a population of 161,379, is the largest. Three other cities—Dallas, Houston, and Fort Worth—have more than 100,000 inhabitants each. (See Tables 3 and 4.)

The following summary shows, for each city having 25,000 or more inhabitants in 1920, the population at each census for which figures are available, together with the number and per cent of increase during the preceding decade:

Urban and rural population.—The Census Bureau defines urban population as that residing in cities and other incorporated places having 2,500 inhabitants or more, and rural population as that residing outside such incorporated places.

The following summary presents, for the last three censuses, figures showing the urban and rural population of the state distributed among places grouped according to specified limits of population. The classification for each census is based upon the popula-

tion of the various places as shown by the returns of that census. Consequently the territory comprised within any one class of cities or that designated as urban or as rural does not remain fixed, because any given place may, through the growth or the decline of its population, pass from one class to another at successive censuses. The proportion of the population of Texas living in places of 2,500 or more increased from 17.1 per cent in 1900 to 24.1 per cent in 1910 and to 32.4 per cent in 1920.

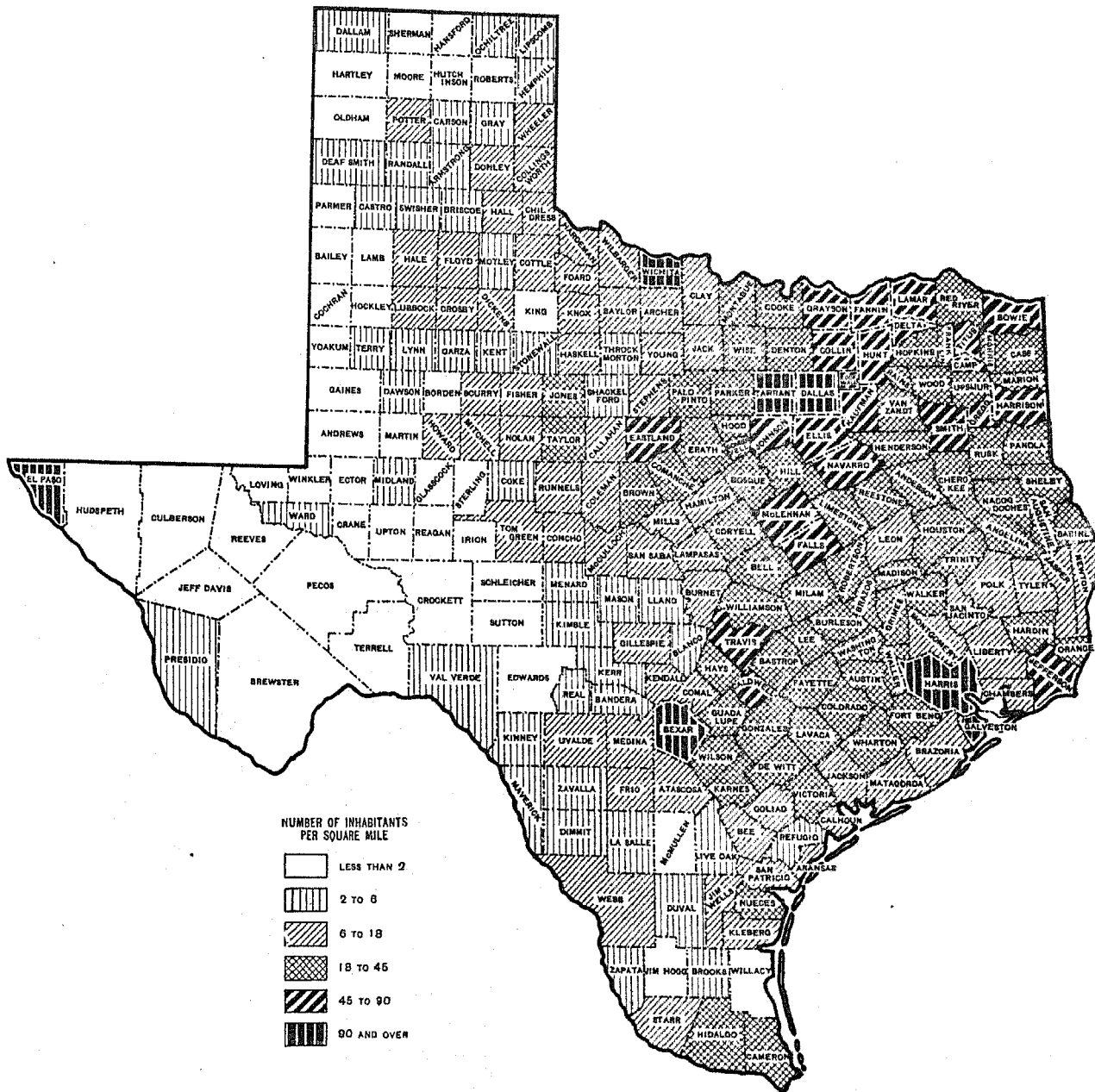

DENSITY OF POPULATION OF TEXAS, BY COUNTIES: 1920.

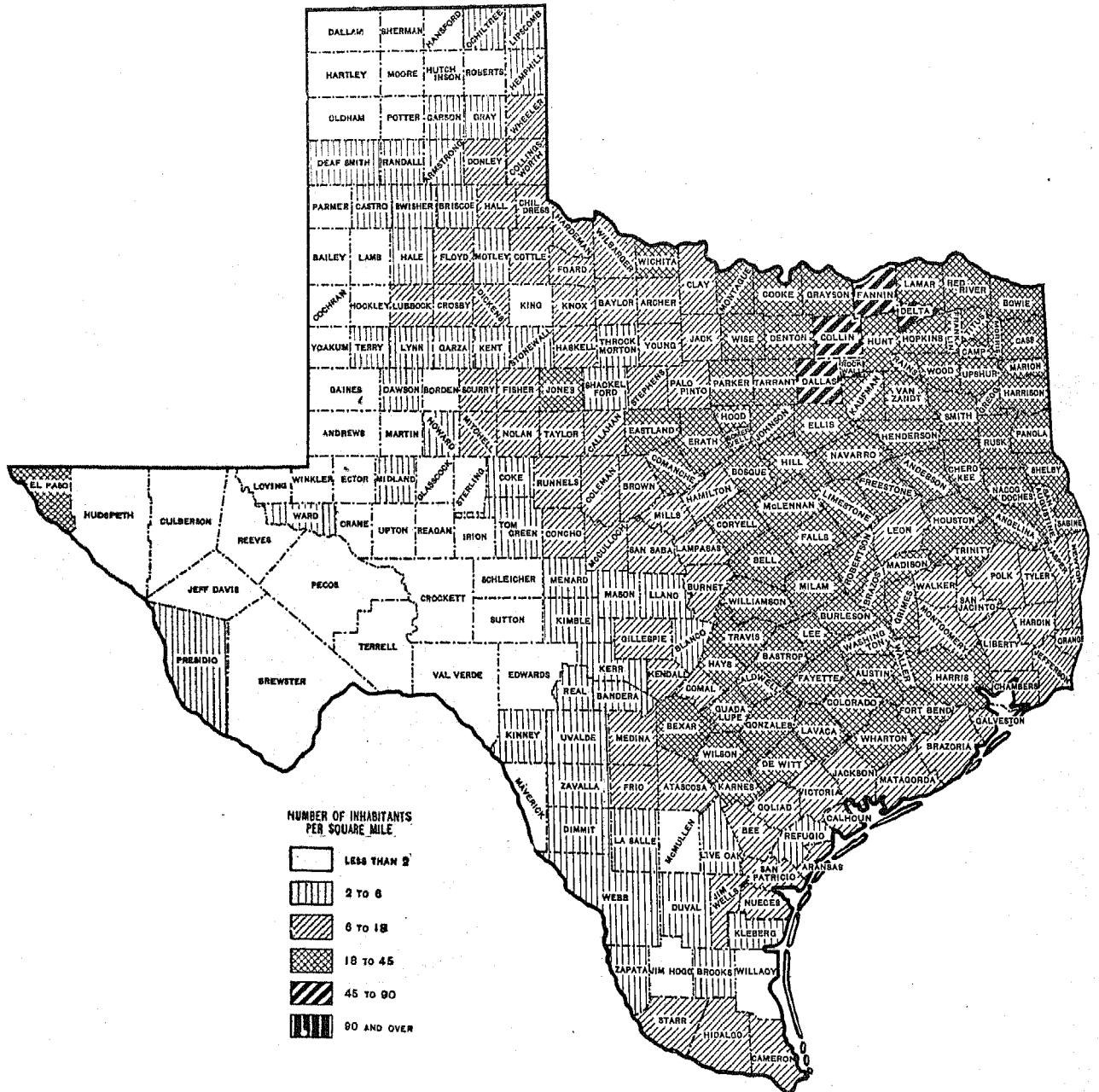

CHANGES IN BOUNDARIES, ETC.

THE STATE.—Totals include population as follows: Indians specially enumerated in 1890 and not returned as part of population of any county (4); population of Buchel and Foley Counties (323 in 1890), annexed to Brewster County in 1897; population of Encinal County (2,744 in 1890; 1,902 in 1880; 427 in 1870; 43 in 1860), annexed to Webb County in 1899; population of Bexar district (1,077 in 1870), taken to form numerous counties in 1876; and population of old Dawson County (281 in 1860)—no records to account for disappearance.

ARANSAS.—Organized from part of Refugio in 1871.

AUSTIN.—Part taken to form part of Waller in 1873.

BAILEY.—Organized from unorganized county of Bailey in 1919.

CASPER.—Organized from part of Tom Green in 1880.

COMANCHE.—Part taken to form part of Mills in 1887.

CRANE.—Formed from part of Tom Green in 1887.

CROCKETT.—Parts taken to form Schleicher and Sutton in 1887 and part of Val Verde in 1885.

CULBERSON.—Organized from part of El Paso in 1911.

DAWSON.—Organized from unorganized county of Dawson in 1905.

DELTA.—Organized from parts of Hopkins and Lamar in 1870.
