WHEREAS, such a sister city program would benefit the people of the affiliated cities through the exchange of cultural exhibits, educational programs and other matters of common interest; and

WHEREAS, the affiliation of Honolulu with the City of Hiroshima, Japan, as sister cities, was suggested at the pre-conference meeting of Japanese and American Mayors and Chamber of Commerce officials held on May 11, 1959 in Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu would be pleased and honored to be affiliated with the City of Hiroshima as a sister city; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of Honolulu that the City and County of Honolulu hereby extends an invitation to the City of Hiroshima, Japan, to enter into a sister city program with Honolulu.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Hiroshima be and is hereby requested to take whatever action may be necessary to effect the affiliation, if it is in favor of the proposal.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the City and County Clerk forward a copy of this resolution to both the Mayor and the Council of the City of Hiroshima.
