RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has originated a sister-city program to foster friendship and understanding on the municipal level to augment our national and foreign policy, through development of mutual trust and understanding among all the peoples of the world; and

WHEREAS, such a sister-city program benefits the people affiliated cities through the exchange of cultural exhibits, educational programs, visits by citizen groups and other matters of common interest; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kaoshiung, Taiwan, Republic of China, has suggested entering into a sister-city relationship with the City and County of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu is pleased and honored by this proposal to establish a sister-city relationship with the City of Kaoshiung; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City and County of Honolulu, State of Hawaii, United States of America, that the City and County of Honolulu hereby accepts the kind invitation extended by the City of Kaoshiung, Taiwan, Republic of China, to enter into a sister-city relationship; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be, and he is, hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Mayor and Council of the City of Kaoshiung, Taiwan, Republic of China; and

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that with said Resolution, the Mayor and Council extend the fond Aloha of the people of the City of Honolulu to the people of her sister-city, Kaoshiung, Taiwan, Republic of China.
