WHEREAS, the Office of the President of the United States of America has inaugurated and endorsed a Sister-City Program to foster friendship and understanding on the municipal level to augment our national and foreign policy through development of mutual trust and good will among the peoples of the world; and

WHEREAS, the point of national origin of many of the valued good citizens and families of the City and County of Honolulu is the Ilocos Region of the Philippine Republic, and Laoag City is both the capital of Ilocos Norte and the commercial, cultural and educational center of the Region; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Jose Evangelista, Governor of Ilocos Norte, and the Honorable Eulalio F. Siazon, Mayor of Laoag City, have indicated their enthusiastic support of a Sister-City relationship between Laoag City and the City and County of Honolulu as proposed by the Honorable Frank F. Fasi, Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, such a Sister-City relationship benefits the people of the affiliated cities through the exchange of cultural exhibits, educational programs, and exchange visits of citizen groups as well as of government officials; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu would be both pleased and honored to establish a Sister-City relationship with Laoag City and the good people thereof; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu, State of Hawaii, United States of America, that a Sister-City relationship, to become effective on July 4, 1969, is hereby established between Laoag City, Ilocos Norte, Republic of the Philippines, and the City and County of Honolulu; and
