

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Office of the President of the United States of America has inaugurated and endorsed a Sister-City Program to foster friendship and understanding on the municipal level to augment our national and foreign policy through development of mutual trust and good will among the peoples of the world; and

WHEREAS, the point of national origin of many of valued good citizens and families of the City and County of Honolulu is the Republic of Korea and the City of Seoul is both the capital of the Republic of Korea and the commercial, cultural and educational center of the Republic of Korea; and

WHEREAS, the year nineteen hundred and seventy-three is especially auspicious inasmuch as the seventieth anniversary of Korean immigration to Hawaii was commemorated this year; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Taek Shik Yang, Mayor of Seoul and the Honorable Bong-Kyun Kim, Superintendent General, Chief of Foreign Affairs Division of the Korean National Police, have indicated their enthusiastic support of a Sister-City relationship between Seoul and the City and County of Honolulu as proposed by the Honorable Frank F. Fasi, Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, such a Sister-City relationship benefits the people of the affiliated cities through the exchange of information on city development, cultural exhibits, educational programs, mutual assistance in developing and fostering the tourist industry, and through exchange visits of citizen groups as well as of government officials; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu would be both pleased and honored to establish a Sister-City relationship with the City of Seoul and the good people thereof; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu, State of Hawaii, United States of America, that a Sister-City relationship, to become effective on May 20, 1973, is hereby established between the City of Seoul, the Republic of Korea, and the City and County of Honolulu; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Honorable Mayor of the City of Seoul; and

RESOLUTION

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that with said Resolution, the Council extends the warm Aloha of the people of the City and County of Honolulu to the people of her Sister-City, Seoul, and of the Republic of Korea.
