RESOLUTION FOR JAMES G. MARTIN

WHEREAS, James G. Martin has served this state honorably as Governor during the last eight years; and

WHEREAS, during his term has proposed major new funding for highways and roads, enabling North Carolina to make the most massive commitment to transportation since the 1950s; and

WHEREAS, under Governor James G. Martin's leadership, the transportation industry has improved its efficiency by recycling asphalt for construction, using private contractors to do work previously performed at greater expense by the state and getting more highways and roads for each dollar spent; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure as governor, he has provided the leadership and direction that has resulted in significant progress in our transportation system throughout North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Governor James G. Martin has made significant and invaluable contributions to the state and people of North Carolina.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That Interstate 485 (Charlotte Outer Loop) from Interstate-77 south to Interstate 85 north is hereby named in honor of Governor James G. Martin.

That the N.C. Department of Transportation erect appropriate signs for such dedication.
